FEDERAL PRIZE FOR ART STUDENTS
25th Federal Competition of the Federal Ministry of Education and Research
12 November 2021 - 30 January 2022

Every two years, 48 selected students from the 24 German art colleges and art academies apply for the Federal Prize for Art Students. It is endowed with 30,000 euros in prize money and 18,000 euros for production grants to create new works for exhibition in the Bundeskunsthalle.

In this year's 25th federal competition, the jury selected eight prize winners whose works can be seen and experienced in this exhibition. It is the only exhibition that brings together art students from all over Germany - from Nuremberg to Hamburg and from Karlsruhe to Leipzig.

The works are representative of the art currently being created at the art academies. The spectrum ranges from installation, sculpture, video, performance and painting to multimedia. The Federal Prize for Art Students is a unique forum for young artists in Germany. It can look back on a tradition of almost forty years and is being held for the 25th time this year.
